Pursuant to the self-monitoring report program requirements detailed on pages 3-4 of the Sunshine Canyon Landfill (SCL) Solid Waste Facilities Permit (SWFP), the following information is provided to the LEA for the month of October 2021.

<u>Condition 16.a. – Types & Quantities of Non-Hazardous Waste Received</u> The attached copy of the monthly activity report includes a daily and weekly breakdown of waste tonnages received on site.

<u>Condition 16.b., MRMP 91, Q-B.5.b</u> – Number and Types of Vehicles Using the Facility The attached copy of the monthly activity report includes the type and number of vehicles that use the facility on a daily and weekly basis.

<u>Condition 16.c. – Results of the Hazardous Waste Load Checking Program</u> The types and quantities of hazardous waste and other prohibited wastes found in the waste stream are outlined below. <u>Condition 16.e., Q-C.2, IMP X.B.7 & IMP X.B.6 – Compliance Summary</u> There were no private citizen caller complaints through the Sunshine Canyon 24hour hotline in October 2021. A copy of the hotline call log for October 2021 is attached.

Condition 16.f. – Record of Receipt of Violation

SCL receive two NOV's from SCAQMD, first on October 5 and second on October 15, 2021 for alleged odors on October 4 and October 14, 2021. SCL did not receive any AOC's during the month of October.

SCL received an NOV on October 6 from City of LA Sanitation for dissolved sulfides levels exceeding the threshold of 0.1 mg/L from a sampled collected on September 20 at 0.31 mg/L.

SCL received an NOV on October 20 from CUPA LACFD for improper labeling of hazardous waste drums in the hazardous waste storage area.

<u>Condition 16.g., MRMP 34a-d – Results of Landfill Gas Monitoring & Control</u> The 2021 Second quarter 1150.1 Monitoring Report was submitted to SCAQMD on August 12th, 2021.

I am looking into the history and potential issues (i.e. back pressure, tank cleanings, line jetting, dosing pumps, etc.) that might have changed our results during this time period. Between these days, I have collected samples that were below detectable levels.

I shall response to the Bureau within the due date of 10/16/2021 and collect the additional samples to show the system is below the local limit.
