Detailed Description of Occurrence:

At approximately 10:30 am, during a routine site inspection, the site team identified an area on the slope north of Part 4 and east of Part 3 that looked to be a potential sub surface oxidation event (SSO).

Actions taken to mitigate this occurrence:

The area identified was a small depression approximately one square foot. After discovering the area, the team responded by added additional cover and moisture condition and track walked area. Probes have since been installed around the area of the SSO and a reading will be taken this afternoon. The team is actively investigating the cause and will continue to gather data until the SSO event is completely snuffed, and update the group accordingly. Additional data will be provided as we have it.

Yesterday at approximately 10:30 am, during routine site inspections, the site Team identified an area on the slope, north of Part 4 and east of Part 3 that looked to be a potential sub surface oxidation event (SSO).

The area identified was a small depression approximately one square foot. After discovering this area, the team responded by added additional cover and moisture condition and track walked the area.

Probes have since been installed around the area of the SSO, and a reading will be taken this afternoon. The team is actively investigating the cause and will continue to gather data until the SSO event is completely snuffed, and update the group accordingly.

The operator was reminded to work on removing the scattered and accumulated litter around the site. Windblown materials shall be controlled to prevent injury to the public and personnel. Litter shall be controlled, routinely collected and disposed of properly, pursuant to 27 CCR 20830. During this observation period, litter pickers were seen collecting windblown litter on site and off site along San Fernando Road.

Two working faces were in use in the areas of CC3-A and CC3-B. The alternative daily covers were effective in covering up all waste at the end of the day's operation.

The spotters were directing traffic.

The portable water-atomizing cannons were in use. Misters were also in use on the perimeter fences and along the haul road for odor control.

The water trucks and sweepers were in use for dust control.

The bird control measures were in place to control the birds.

The load checks were conducted during this observation period.

The lining work of the next cell, Cell CC4-Part 4B/C, continued during this observation period.

The construction of the berm and a new haul road, near the front of the landfill, continued during this observation period. The construction did not interfere with normal traffic flow in and out of the landfill, or caused on-site safety hazards. A spotter was present and road signs were posted and visible to the drivers on the current haul road, as of this observation period.

The compliance perimeter gas probes on the city and the county sides were monitored during this inspection period. All perimeter probes were either non-detect for methane gas or below 1%, by volume, except for probes: 205R-C 1.3%, 205R-D 2.9%.
