

**On 08/30/2023, a joint perimeter gas probes monitoring was conducted on the county side. Probes 245-B and 205R-D had methane concentrations of 3.0% and 3.7%, respectively, by volume, in air.**

**Compliance Wells # 245 and 205R should be further monitored to determine if the methane gas increases came from landfill gas migration or from natural decomposition in the saturated native soil due to the heavy rainfall earlier in the year. The significant increase in the stockpile of dirt in the nearby area may also contribute to the migration of landfill gases to the perimeter probes.**

### Inspection Report Comments

This report is a compilation of the SCL-LEA staff observations for the month of August 2023.

During this observation period, Hurricane Hilary affected the region and the landfill from Sunday, August 20 to Monday, August 21 - with heavy rain falling on Sunday, August 20. Last time a tropical storm hit the region was in 1939. The storm was called El Cordonazo. During Hurricane Hilary, the landfill received a total of 5.44 inches of rain in less than the 24 hour period. The landfill experienced some problems due to this rainstorm. The runoff from the higher elevation and from cell CC4 caused gullies in the dirt cover that exposed the landfilled trash. Several erosional rills with exposed trash in the daily cover were also observed along the slopes of cell CC3 and cell CC4. Muddy road conditions with some ponding was observed during the rainstorm. No waste from the landfill appeared to have left the site during this observation period.

The operator is required to submit a Wet Weather Plan to the SCL-LEA by October 1, 2023, detailing the stormwater runoff management measures that will be in place to prepare for the coming wet weather season.

The asphalt lined road leading to the wet weather working face in the CC4 Part 1 & 2 area was in use during and immediately after the storm events.

As of the end of August 2023, all of the areas of exposed waste have been covered with dirt and the erosional ruts have been repaired.

During this observation period, except for the Hurricane Hilary rainstorm days, the weather conditions were hot and dry. The landfill operations were mostly aimed at minimizing dust generation and dust control. The waste hauling roads and the working face areas were watered regularly during the disposal operation.

The construction of the berm continued during dry days this observation period. A spotter was present to direct traffic at the point of the intersection. The new haul road at the entrance was asphalt lined, completed and utilized towards the end of the month. Road signs reflecting the road changes were posted and visible to the drivers on the haul road.

Currently, ADC [the plastic alternative daily cover, ADC ] (Enviro cover) and soil are being used for daily cover.

The spotters were directing traffic during this observation period.

The bird control measures were in place to control the birds.

The water trucks, street sweepers were in use for dust control on dry days.

Misting system on the perimeter fences and along the haul road was operational during this period to control odors.

The load checks were conducted during this observation period.

The compliance perimeter gas probes on the city and the county sides were monitored during this inspection period. All perimeter probes were either non-detect for methane gas or below 1%, by volume, except for probes: 243-A - 1.9%, 245-B - 3% 205R-C 2.3%, 205R-D 3.7% and 245-B 3.0%. An Area of Concern was noted for the rise in methane concentration at Probe 205R-D and 245-B.

On 09/21/2023, the county side perimeter gas probes monitoring was conducted. Probes 205R-D and 245-B had methane concentration of 3.9% and 3.1%, respectively, by volume, in air. Compliance Wells #205R and #245 should be further monitored to determine if the methane gas increases came from landfill gas migration, or from natural decomposition in the saturated native soil due to the recent heavy rainfall from Hurricane Hilary. The compliance perimeter gas probes on the city side was also monitored during this inspection period. All perimeter probes were either non-detect for methane gas or below 1%, by volume, except for probes: 205R-C @ 2.1%, 205R-D @ 3.9%, 243-A @ 1.9% and 245-B @ 3.1%.

**Inspection Report Comments**

This report is a compilation of the SCL-LEA staff observations for the month of 2023 September.

The landfill was closed on Monday, September 4th in observation of Labor Day.

Weather conditions were mostly hot and dry with two days of rain during this inspection period. The landfill received approximately 0.53 inch of accumulated rainfall on September 2nd and September 30th, according to the operator's rain gauge located on the South City area of the landfill. The landfill held up well despite the rainfall, as of this inspection.

One working face was in use in the CC4-Part 4 B/C area. The dirt covers and the alternative daily covers were effective in covering up all waste at the end of the day's operation.

The spotters were directing traffic during this observation period.

The bird control measures were in place to control the birds.

The water trucks and sweepers were in use for dust control on the days that did not rain.

The portable water-atomizing cannons were in use. Misters were also in use on the perimeter fences and along the haul road for odor control.

The load checks were conducted during this observation period.

The operator has been preparing the site for the coming wet weather season and will submit a Wet Weather Plan to the SCL-LEA by October 1, 2023. The excavation of the settled sediment in the Terminal Basin, from the runoffs of the recent Hurricane Hilary, the construction of the berm wall and a new haul road near the front of the landfill continued during this observation period. The construction did not interfere with normal traffic flow in and out of the landfill, or caused on-site safety hazards. A spotter was present and road signs were posted and visible to the drivers on the current haul road, as of this observation period.
