

What is a Notice of Violation?

A Notice of Violation is issued by an SCAQMD Air Quality Inspector to inform a business that a failure to comply with one or more applicable federal, state, and/or local (SCAQMD) air pollution rules and regulations or legal requirements is being alleged.

What happens when I receive a Notice of Violation?

If you are operating in violation of one or more applicable federal, state, and/or local (SCAQMD) air pollution rules and regulations or legal requirements, each day or part of a day that you operate in violation is considered a separate violation even if only one Notice of Violation has been issued. Continuing to operate in violation may subject you to substantial civil or criminal penalties. **It is in your best interest to resolve any compliance problem immediately before you resume operation.**

What if I need to continue to operate the equipment named in the Notice of Violation?

If continued operation of equipment cited in the Notice of Violation is necessary, you may be able to obtain a variance from SCAQMD's Hearing Board. A **variance** is an administrative order that allows a company to continue operating without penalties while it takes appropriate steps to meet air pollution control requirements. Proof of specific legal circumstances must be provided before a variance can be granted. Timeliness in seeking such relief will be considered by the Hearing Board. Additional information concerning variances can be found in California Health & Safety Code §§ 42350-42359.5 and at <http://www.aqmd.gov/home/about/hearing-board>.

During a hearing for a variance, you may be represented either by yourself or by your attorney or consultant. You will have the opportunity to present evidence and testimony, and to cross-examine any SCAQMD witness.

If you fail to comply with any order of the Hearing Board, you may be subject to additional civil or criminal penalties set forth in California Health & Safety Code §§ 42400 *et seq.* and 42402 *et seq.*

How are Notices of Violation resolved?

The SCAQMD General Counsel's office reviews each alleged violation and, based on the facts, determines how best to resolve the allegation. Options available to the General Counsel's office include:

- **Minor Source Penalty Assessment Program**

Certain Notices of Violation may be eligible for resolution through SCAQMD's Minor Source Penalty Assessment Program if they are issued to

a minor source or for violations other than emitting air toxics or creating a public nuisance involving injury or property damage.

If your case is handled by this program, you will receive a letter or phone call from an investigator in the SCAQMD General Counsel's office offering to settle your violation. Settlement terms usually call for a penalty payment and written proof of current compliance. The investigator's name and telephone number are included in the initial settlement letter in the event you would like to discuss the case.

Be prepared to describe any facts about the violation that you believe SCAQMD should know in considering your case. Sharing your knowledge of the facts, possible causes for the violation and plans to avoid future violations will help the investigator arrive at an appropriate disposition.

Be sure to respond by the date indicated in the letter to avoid further legal action.

If the Minor Source Penalty Assessment Program fails to result in a settlement, your Notice of Violation may be referred to an SCAQMD attorney and handled under the procedures for Civil Prosecution or resolved through a Small Claims Court.

- **Civil Prosecution**

If your case is handled as a civil matter, it will be reviewed by an attorney from the SCAQMD General Counsel's office, who will typically make first contact with you through a letter that asks for information about your case. If the allegations in the Notice of Violation cannot be informally resolved, the SCAQMD is authorized to file a civil lawsuit in court to recover civil penalties. In cases involving serious harm or danger, however, SCAQMD may immediately commence a legal action for civil penalties and a court-ordered injunction. A **mandatory injunction** is a court order compelling a person and/or company to take specific action. A **prohibitory injunction** is a court order compelling a person and/or company to refrain from taking a specific action. Injunctions, which may even lead to shutting down a business, may be sought by SCAQMD to prevent continuing or serious violations or damages from occurring.

- **Criminal Prosecution**

If SCAQMD determines that criminal prosecution is appropriate, the case will be referred to the appropriate state or federal law enforcement agency. That agency will determine if criminal prosecution is warranted.

Civil and Criminal Penalties

Penalties are determined by California Health & Safety Code §§ 42400 *et seq.* and 42402 *et seq.*

Available Resources

The above facility was inspected for compliance with applicable sections of Division 30 of the Public Resources Code (PRC) and Title 14 and Title 27, California Code of Regulations (CCR).

Violations

27 CCR 20820 - Drainage and Erosion Control

The drainage system shall be designed and maintained to:

- (1) ensure integrity of roads, structures, and gas monitoring and control systems;
- (2) prevent safety hazards; and
- (3) prevent exposure of waste.

Torrential rainstorms continue to affect the region throughout the month of February depositing between 19.72 inches of total rain onto the landfill for the month. The landfill experienced some problems with the drainage system due to the deluge of storm water, which resulted in erosions in the side of the slopes and some waste being

exposed primarily on the slope of CC4-Part 4A in the vicinity of the temporary drainage channels. After the downpour, the heavy equipment operators made some repairs to the cover, but had difficulties accessing the saturated areas of the slope to complete the repair. Throughout the month, the operator was able to work on the eroded areas when the ground was more stable for the heavy equipment to enter. However, the operator was not able to fully cover the exposed trash in this area by the end of the month. No waste from the landfill appeared to have left the site during this observation period.

The operator is to take immediate action to cover the exposed trash and repair the erosion on the slopes. As indicated in the wet weather plan, the site management is to assess the landfill and document any areas of the landfill that were damaged in the storm and provide the SCL LEA with a report detailing the repairs necessary and anticipated completion dates.

On February 26th, the SCL LEA discovered cracking in the temporary internal concrete wall of the terminal sediment basin in the front of the site. Water was observed coming out of the corner joint of the concrete slabs and pouring into the terminal basin. The SCL LEA made referrals to the proper regulatory agencies.

The operator is to conduct an assessment of the terminal sediment basin and report back to the SCL LEA as to the extent of the damage and what repairs will be required.

27 CCR 20700 - Intermediate Cover

(a) Compacted earthen material of at least twelve (12) inches shall be placed on all surfaces of the fill where no additional solid waste will be deposited within 180 days to control vectors, fires, odors, blowing litter, and scavenging.

During the inspection of the new onsite haul road being constructed on the old City-South section of the landfill, the LEA observed a few small areas of old exposed trash. It appears that the contractor was grading a section of the slope for the new road and hit a small vein of old trash. No odors were detected in the immediate area and the trash appears to mainly consist of plastics and metal.

The operator is to take immediate steps to cover all of the exposed trash in this area of intermediate cover. The operator will need to assess the damaged section of the intermediate cover and make the appropriate repairs to this area to return it to its previous condition prior to the completion of the new haul road.

27 CCR 20690 - Alternative Daily Cover

Pursuant to 27 CCR 20690 (a)(2), the landfill operator is required to place over the entire working face at the end of each operating day either an approved alternative daily cover (ADC) or compacted earthen material to control vectors, fires, odors, blowing litter, and scavenging without presenting a threat to human health and the environment.

On Saturday, February 10th, the landfill was not able to place either an ADC or a soil cover over the working face due to the muddy conditions. The working face was left with a combination of mud and exposed trash over the weekend.

The operator is to ensure that at the end of each working day that all trash on the working face is covered with either an approved ADC or 6 inches of compacted soil. If the daily cover or ADC cannot be applied due to weather conditions, acceptance of additional loads shall cease until such time that the landfill can function according to regulations.

Areas of Concern

27 CCR 20921 - Gas Monitoring and Control

(a) To provide for the protection of public health and safety and the environment, the operator shall ensure that landfill gas generated at a disposal site is controlled in such a manner as to satisfy the following requirements:

(1) The concentration of methane gas must not exceed 1.25 percent by volume in air within any portion of any on-site structures.

(2) The concentration of methane gas migrating from the disposal site must not exceed 5 percent by volume in air at the disposal site permitted facility boundary or an alternative boundary approved in accordance with Section 20925.

During this observation period, the city and county side perimeter gas probes monitoring was conducted. All perimeter probes were either non-detect for methane gas or below 1%, by volume, except for probes: 205R-D @ 2.3%, and 245-B @ 3.1%. Compliance Wells #205R, and #245 should be further monitored to determine if the methane gas increases came from landfill gas migration, or from natural decomposition in the native soil.

27 CCR 20830 - Litter Control

Litter shall be controlled, routinely collected and disposed off properly. Windblown materials shall be controlled to prevent injury to the public and personnel. Controls shall prevent the accumulation, or off-site migration, of litter in quantities that create a nuisance or cause other problems.

The LEA staff observed windblown litter throughout the site during this observation period with more litter concentration in the CC4 Part 4 area as well as South City area, the side slopes, trees and hillsides along the southern ridge of the landfill. The operator had deployed litter pickers along the fence line and on the slopes in the CC4 Part 4 area to pick up the litter during dry days. No litter has been carried off-site by the wind towards the neighborhood during this observation period. Windblown materials need to be better controlled to prevent the accumulation and off-site migration of litter.

27 CCR 20650 - Grading of Fill Surfaces

Covered surfaces of the disposal area shall be graded to promote lateral runoff of precipitation and to prevent ponding. Grades shall be established of sufficient slopes to

account for future settlement of the fill surface.

During this month storm events, some ponds formed in the CC4-Part 4 B/C area, near exit haul road and at City South areas. The ponds were being pumped out by the end of this observation period.

The covered surfaces of the disposal area must be graded to promote lateral runoff of precipitation and of sufficient slopes to prevent water accumulation and/or infiltration into any filled areas.

The water trucks and sweepers were in use for dust control on the days that did not rain.
The portable water-atomizing cannons were in use. Misters were also in use on the perimeter fences and along the haul road for odor control.
There were adequate lighting during the hours of darkness during this observation period.
The load checks were conducted during this observation period.
