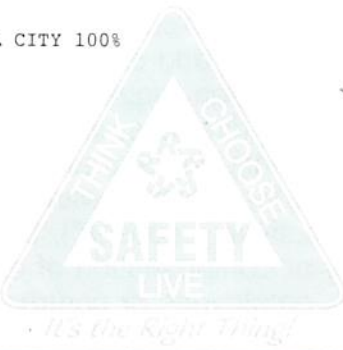

However, the operator was not able to fully cover the exposed and Tracked-in trash across the Wet Weather Deck area, CC4-Part 2, of the landfill by the end of the month. No waste from the landfill appeared to have left the site during this observation period.

The operator is to take immediate action to cover the exposed trash. As indicated in the wet weather plan, the site management is to assess the landfill and document any areas of the landfill that were damaged and provide the SCL-LEA with a report detailing the repairs necessary and anticipated completion dates.

No Areas of Concern

Inspection Report Comments

This report is a compilation of the SCL-LEA staff observations for the month of 2024 April.

A violation was noted for Drainage & Erosion Control. The violation for Intermediate Cover that was noted in the month of March was corrected by the end of this inspection period.

Weather conditions were mostly cool with two days of rain during this inspection period. The landfill received approximately one and a half inch of accumulated rainfall in the month of April, according to the available online weather data with weather stations that are located most proximal to the landfill.

The spotters were directing traffic during this observation period.

The water trucks and sweepers were in use for dust control on the days that did not rain. The portable water-atomizing cannons were in use. Mistlers were also in use on the perimeter fences and along the haul road for odor control.

There were adequate lighting during the hours of darkness during this observation period.

The load checks were conducted during this observation period.

The compliance perimeter gas probes on the city and the county sides were monitored during this inspection period. All perimeter probes were either non-detect for methane gas or below 1%, by volume, except for the probe: 243-A @ 1.3%.

The construction of the new diverted haul road near the front of the landfill and the new scale house platform continued during this observation period. The construction did not cause significant interference with the normal traffic flow in and out of the landfill, or caused on-site safety hazards. Spotters were present when necessary and road signs were posted and

trash on the slopes as of the end of this observation period. The operator was working to cover the remaining spots of erosion in the Wet Weather Deck and the CC3 areas, as of the end of May.

As the operator is repairing the eroded areas, the areas which will be filled with new trash, within 180 days, are required to have at least six (6) inches of soil cover. The intermediate cover areas are required to have at least twelve (12) inches of soil cover.

As indicated in the wet weather plan, site management is to continue assessing the landfill and document any remaining areas of the landfill that were damaged in this past winter storms and work with the SCL-LEA until all repairs are completed.

The landfill received 0.20 inch of rain for the month of May, according to the operator's rain gauge located on the landfill. In total, the landfill received 35.17 inches of rain for this past winter season, between the months of 2023 October to 2024 May, with almost twenty (20) inches of rainfall in the month of 2024 February alone.

This report is a compilation of the SCL-LEA staff observations for the month of 2024 May.

An Area of Concern was noted for Drainage & Erosion Control.

The spotters were directing traffic during this observation period.

The water trucks and sweepers were in use for dust control on the days that did not rain.

The portable water-atomizing cannons were in use. Misters were also in use on the perimeter fences and along the haul road for odor control.

There were adequate lighting during the hours of darkness during this observation period.

The load checks were conducted during this observation period.

The compliance perimeter gas probes on the city and the county sides were monitored during this inspection period. All perimeter probes were either non-detect for methane gas, or below 1%, by volume, except for probes: 205R-C @ 2.6%, 205R-D @ 2.4% and 245-B @ 2.2%.

The construction of the new diverted haul road at the front of the landfill was completed and truck traffic was diverted onto this new road as of this observation period.

The construction of the liner-anchoring berm and its related storm water drainage system near the front of the landfill continued during this observation period. The old haul road is being excavated in phases to prepare for the next cell. The construction did not cause significant interference with the normal traffic flow in and out of the landfill, or caused on-site safety hazards. Spotters were present when necessary and road signs were posted and visible to the drivers on the current haul road, as of this observation period.
