

(2) The concentration of methane gas migrating from the disposal site must not exceed 5 percent by volume in air at the disposal site permitted facility boundary or an alternative boundary approved in accordance with Section 20925.

The compliance perimeter gas probes on the city and the county sides were monitored during this inspection period. Probe 245-B had a 5.5%, by volume, methane gas concentration reading at the time of the inspection. Two independent gas monitors were concurrently used at the time of the inspection and both gas monitors received similar reading results.

The remaining perimeter probes were either non-detect for methane gas, or below 1%, by volume, except for probes: 205R-C @ 2.1%, 205R-D @ 3.5%, 245-C @ 1.6% and 245-D @ 1.7%. Compliance Wells #205R and #245 continue to be monitored for changes in methane gas concentration as of the end of this observation period.

On May 23, 2025, the operator submitted a Gas Remediation Workplan to the SCL-LEA for the 2025 March methane gas exceedance at the perimeter probe 245-B.

The operator has been implementing their proposed corrective actions of:

1. Additional tuning of LFG extraction wells located in the area.
2. Design and installation of new LFG extraction wells in the area of the probe.
3. Tuning and monitoring of new LFG extraction wells for a 60-day period.
4. Installation of a soil vapor extraction well in the area of the probe if elevated methane persists.

As of this day, installation of new LFG extraction wells has been suspended throughout the site until further notice due to the fatality incident that occurred on 6-25-25.

The operator was requested to submit an update to the SCL-LEA on the stages in development of their corrective actions plan to address the methane gas exceedance at probe 245-B.

Areas of Concern

27 CCR 20700 - Intermediate Cover

(a) Compacted earthen material of at least twelve (12) inches shall be placed on all surfaces of the fill where no additional solid waste will be deposited within 180 days to control vectors, fires, odors, blowing litter, and scavenging.

During this observation period, spot areas of tracked-in trash and litter were noted around the CC4-P2 and P3 intermediate cover zones in the county portion of the landfill. The LEA discussed this issue with the operator, who provided a schedule for fully re-covering these spots. The operator has imported soil for those repairs and to reinforce the intermediate cover by compacting the side slopes as part of their

winterization plan. However, some sections still require more thorough coverage.

The operator must ensure that intermediate cover is properly maintained throughout all seasons.

Inspection Report Comments

This report is a compilation of the SCL-LEA staff observations for the month of 2025 June.

On 6/25/2025, a heavy equipment accident occurred involving a third party contractor's crew during preparation for drilling a landfill gas well. Tragically, this accident resulted in a fatality of an employee of the third party contractor. The landfill operation was subsequently shut down for the remainder of the day, and has resumed operations on 6/26/2025, though drilling activities remain temporarily suspended. Cal/OSHA is currently conducting an investigation into this incident.

Weather conditions were sunny and warm for this observation period.
Two working faces were in use in the CC3-Part B & the new CC5 areas.
The spotters were directing traffic during this observation period.
The water trucks and sweepers were in use for dust control.
The bird control measures were in place to control the birds during this observation period.

The portable water-atomizing cannons were in use. Mistlers were also in use on the perimeter fences and along the haul road for odor control. The load checks were conducted during this observation period.

The construction of the flooring for the final cell is underway. The construction did not cause interference with the normal traffic flow in and out of the landfill as of this observation period. Spotters were present to direct construction truck traffic when needed. Road signs were posted and visible to the drivers along the current haul road.
