The following is the Monthly Summary for March 2026, which covers all requested weekly information regarding soil import activities from March 1, 2026, through March 30, 2026.

For the month of March 2026, the material included in the table above was received only from WF Holdings, LLC and Tutor-Purple Line 2.

When material arrives at the site, site personnel make real-time decisions to either send the material directly to the working face for application as daily cover/a staging area directly next to the working face for use that week, or directly to a maintenance/beneficial use project elsewhere on the site. Any material that is not utilized immediately within the week for one of these two uses is stockpiled for future use (see attached map indicating location of stockpile).

The 2,500 tpd limit on beneficial reuse material does not apply to clean dirt used as daily cover.

On August 7, 2024 LA County DPW approved the implementation of the ADC Weekend Pilot Project. Therefore, ADC was utilized on March 7, 14, 21, and 28th in accordance with the ADC approvals.
